Parker place is getting fit in January, we are going to kick off the New Year by challenging the residents and staff in Lets Get Fit !

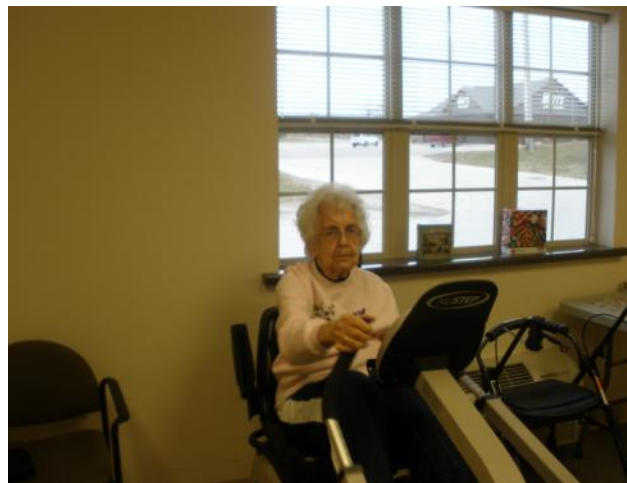
For those wanting to get involved we will be splitting into teams and will be keeping track of all the exercising we have done for the month of January.

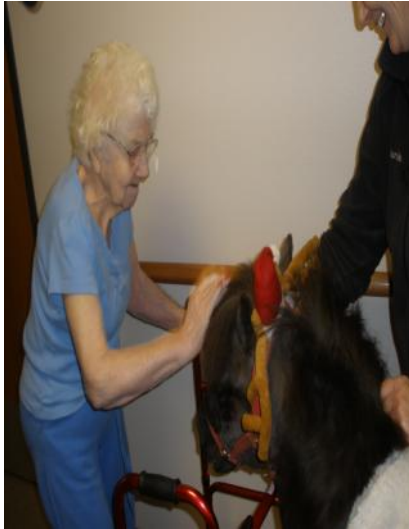

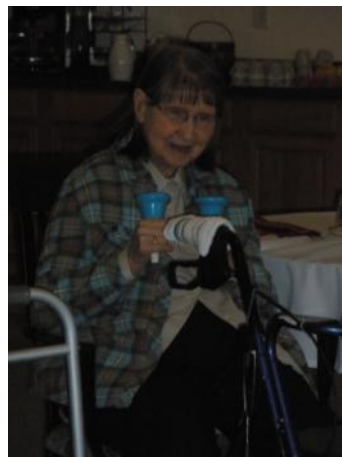

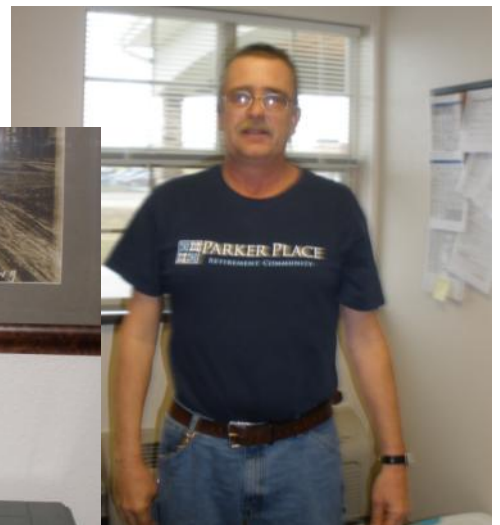
Parker Place Happenings
